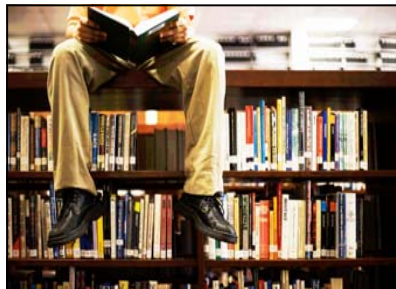

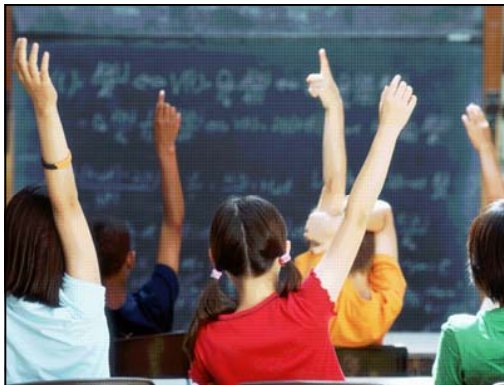
## Our Vision:
